#### **Minimum Entry Requirements**

To qualify for, the course above, one should

- At least possess a Uganda Certificate of Education with at least a pass in Biology and Geography or its
  equivalent. For those whose results are under the New Lower Secondary Curriculum, it should be at least
  a D in the above-mentioned subjects.
- Be fluent in English (written and spoken) and should possess basic computer skills.

#### **Application procedure**

- i. Application Forms can be obtained from the Office of Avian Conservation Uganda Society (ACUS) located in Kitala-Bukandekande,1.5km off Entebbe road or downloaded from the website at: www.acugs.org
- ii. Completed application forms with all relevant documents attached should be returned to the Office of the Academic Registrar, ACUS School of Ornithology at the office of ACUS, or emailed to: ar@acugs.org
- iii. Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from the Uganda National Examinations Board (UNEB). Incomplete applications **shall not** be processed.

iv. The application process is free of charge

## Other pertinent information

- "East Africa" includes applicants/students from; Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, South Sudan, and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC).
- **Training will commence on 3rd May, 2025**. NOTE that the school reserves the right to admit applicants/roll out the advertised program only when the required number of applicants has been realized.
- Fully registered members of ACUS are given a 10% discount on the course fees for each of the course programs.
- Training will be online and Physical for the case of Field Activities, and they will all be taking place on conducted on Weekend days.
